## **Annual Exhibition and Awards**

It has been pointed out there has been some confusion amongst Members about 'what is original work' submitted to a *Judged Exhibition*.

Here is some clarification and will also be in the Conditions of Entry Form that you will receive early July. *Entries will close by 29th July*, for our *Annual Exhibition 16th - 18th August, 2019.* 

#### Please Note:

#### CONDITIONS

All Artworks entered must be the original work of the Artist.

You must not use copies of another Artists work.

Copies of photographs from books, magazines, newspapers or the internet must not be copyright. Artwork can be from a photograph if taken by you, or with written permission of the photographer. Artworks completed at Workshops or Formal Classes are not eligible for Entry.

However, this does not prevent any of us from seeking problem solving advice or critiques from other Artists in informal situations such as on our Monday Night meetings.

Maximum number of paintings that may be entered is three (3) as per below.

- \* 1st Painting Large or Standard
- \* 2nd Painting **Standard** or (Portrait)
- \* 3rd Painting **9x5** only (no more than one 9x5 entry)
- \* Large Maximum size 1 metre in Height or Width (including frame)
- \* **Standard** Maximum size **80cm x 70cm** (including frame)
- \* **9x5** has an internal image size of "exactly" 229mm x 127mm (9inch x 5inch)

#### **Human Portrait Section**

This is a new Section that will be in our Annual Exhibition in August.

One Standard Size (80cm x 70cm Max including frame) This is a half sheet of Colourfix (approx. 46cm x 32cm inside mat)

This will take the place of a normal Standard painting.

The above Conditions apply - also written permission from the person being painted or photographed.


#### What is a Portrait?

A Portrait Painting is an artistic representation of a person in which the face and its expression is predominant and the intent is to display the likeness, personality and even the mood of the Person. (ref. Wikipedia)

Even though the Human Portrait Section is not compulsory, we are looking forward to Members submitting a Portrait in this Section. It will be Judged with 1st Prize and Highly Commended Prize.

So get out those Pastels and give it a go!

- Entrants must be financial members of The Pastel Society of Western Australia.
- There is an Exhibition Entry fee of \$10 per painting.
- Entry forms and fee may be submitted at our Monday sessions, or mail to Trish Spence, The Secretary, The Pastel Society of WA, 3 Cosimo Drive, Woodvale, 6026
- 4. All the entrants must contribute to the set-up and running of the Exhibition. Entrants must supply at least two times that they are available for the Roster. The Roster will be available at Pastels by 12th August. It is your responsibility to find out when you are rostered on duty and attend as rostered. Emails will be sent out to all on Duty.
- All art works must be for sale.
- No late Entries will be accepted and no alterations to the Catalogue can me made.
- A commission of 20% will be charged on sales.
- 8. Maximum number of paintings that may be entered is three (3) as per below.
  - \* 1st Painting Large or Standard
  - \* 2nd Painting Standard or Portrait
  - \* 3rd Painting 9x5 only (no more than one 9x5 entry)
  - \* Large Maximum size 1 metre in Height or Width (including frame)
  - \* Standard Maximum size 80cm x 70cm (including frame)
  - \* 9x5 has an internal image size of "exactly" 229mm x 127mm (9inch x 5inch)
- All paintings must be framed under glass with suitable hanging devices. (D-hooks to be taped over)
- All paintings must be labelled on the back with Title, Artist's Name and Price.
- Artwork must be the artist's own work, subject matter and must not infringe copyright.
   Artworks completed at Workshops or Formal Classes are not eligible for Entry.
- All Paintings will be judged with 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 2 Highly Commended. 9x5 1st Prize & Highly Commended, 1st Prize & Highly Commended Portrait Section & Peoples Choice Awards.
- Works may not be removed prior to 5pm on Sunday.
